A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that votes for questions
 on ballots for the ratification of constitutional amendments
 that are left blank, crossed out, or otherwise defaced, are
 counted in the negative, which may lead to a result that was not
 intended by the voter.

Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require that
each vote cast for a question on a ballot for the ratification
of a constitutional amendment be counted in the negative only if
the ballot properly indicates that the vote is for "no".

10 SECTION 2. Section 11-151, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 amended to read as follows:

12 "§11-151 Vote count. (a) Except for contests conducted 13 by ranked-choice voting pursuant to section 11-100, each contest 14 or question on a ballot shall be counted independently as 15 follows:

16 (1) If the votes cast in a contest or on a question are
17 equal to or less than the number to be elected or

chosen for that contest or question, the votes for 1 that contest or question shall be counted; 2 If the votes cast in a contest or question exceed the 3 (2) number to be elected or chosen for that contest or 4 question, the votes for that contest or question shall 5 not be counted; and 6 7 (3) If a contest or question requires a majority of the votes for passage, any blank, spoiled, or invalid 8 ballot shall not be tallied for passage or as votes 9 cast except that [such] the ballots shall be counted 10 as votes cast in [ratification of a constitutional 11 amendment or] a question for a constitutional 12 convention. 13 14 Each vote cast in ratification of a constitutional (b) amendment shall be counted in the negative only if the ballot 15 properly indicates that the vote is in the negative. No other 16 indication on the ballot, including but not limited to a blank 17 or cross-out, shall be counted in the negative." 18 19 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 20
