
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
THIRTY-FIRST REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$16,753,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2024-2025
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the thirty-
6 first representative district, as follows:

7 1. Aliamanu elementary school

8 Plans, design, and construction for a
9 2,750 ft. x 6 ft. chain link fence with
10 several access points to surround
11 Aliamanu elementary school.

14 Design, construction, and equipment and
15 appurtenances for a synthetic turf
16 field and track improvements and ground
17 and site improvements.

18 Design \$600,000

19 Construction \$5,150,000

20 Equipment \$50,000

21 Total funding \$5,800,000

1 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
2 shall be expended by the department of education.

3 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
4 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
5 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
6 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
7 of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
