
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the aerospace field
2 has played a pivotal role in expanding and diversifying the
3 national economy by forging new inroads to scientific discovery,
4 advancing national engineering and manufacturing expertise,
5 pioneering innovations in communications and computer
6 technologies, enhancing surveillance of our home planet, and
7 enabling a better understanding of weather systems and climate
8 change. In Hawaii, continued support of national space efforts
9 is occurring through a wide range of aerospace-related
10 activities on all major islands, including the Mauna Kea science
11 reserve on the island of Hawaii, the Air Force Maui optical and
12 supercomputing observatory on the island of Maui, the university
13 of Hawaii's institute for astronomy and Hawaii institute for
14 geophysics and planetology on the island of Oahu, and the
15 Pacific missile range facility on the island of Kauai.
16 Additional support of the aerospace industry will enable future
17 development and innovation in science and technology in Hawaii.



1 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to
2 establish a position within the Hawaii technology development
3 corporation to assist the corporation's aerospace coordinator.

4 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
5 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
6 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for
7 the establishment of one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) position
8 within the Hawaii technology development corporation to assist
9 the corporation's aerospace coordinator.

10 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
11 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of
12 this Act.

13 SECTION 3. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
14 the Hawaii State Constitution and sections 37-91 and 37-93,
15 Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined that the
16 appropriations contained in H.B. No. , will cause the state
17 general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be
18 exceeded by \$ or per cent. In addition, the
19 appropriation contained in this Act will cause the general fund
20 expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be further
21 exceeded by \$ or per cent. The combined total



1 amount of general fund appropriations contained in only these
2 two Acts will cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling
3 for fiscal year 2024-2025 to be exceeded by
4 \$ or per cent. The reasons for exceeding the
5 general fund expenditure ceiling are that:

- 6 (1) The appropriation made in this Act is necessary to
7 serve the public interest; and
- 8 (2) The appropriation made in this Act meets the needs
9 addressed by this Act.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
