14 SECTION 3. In accordance with section 9 of article VII, of
15 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
16 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined
17 that the appropriations contained in this Act will cause the
18 state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025
19 to be exceeded by \$ or per cent. The reasons for
20 exceeding the general fund expenditure ceiling are that the




1 appropriations made in this Act are necessary to serve the

3 SECTION 4. The sums appropriated for the respective
4 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
5 department of education for the purposes of this Act.

7 capital projects set forth in section 2 shall be expended by the
8 department of land and natural resources for the purposes of
9 this Act.
