A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BURIAL SITES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that it is necessary to 2 clarify the definition of "burial site" in section 6E-2, Hawaii 3 Revised Statutes, as its current definition results in questionable interpretations involving multiple burials, 4 5 secondary burials, marked burials, associated burial goods, and 6 the immediate surrounding archaeological context of burials. 7 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to clarify the 8 definition of "burial site" to address the problematic aspect of 9 the current definition. 10 SECTION 2. Section 6E-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 amended by amending the definition of "burial site" to read as 12 follows: 13 ""Burial site" means any specific marked or unmarked 14 location where prehistoric or historic human skeletal remains 15 [and their associated burial goods] of an individual or set of 16 individuals are [interred,] found, and [its immediate] the surrounding [archaeological] cultural context, including 17

<u>associated burial goods that may be present</u>, deemed a unique
 class of historic property and not otherwise included in section
 6E-41."

4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
