
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO INSTALL SPEED BUMPS
AND SPEED LIMIT SIGNAGE ON THE PORTION OF KAPOLEI PARKWAY
BETWEEN KAPOLEI HIGH SCHOOL AND KAPOLEI MIDDLE SCHOOL.

1 WHEREAS, according to the National Highway Traffic Safety
2 Administration, speeding is involved in nearly one-third of all
3 motor vehicle fatalities in the United States; and

5 WHEREAS, in Kapolei, speeding is a constant contributing
6 factor in motor vehicle accidents and traffic fatalities; and

8 WHEREAS, pedestrian safety should be a priority for the
9 State and the counties; and

11 WHEREAS, speed bumps and speed limit signage can be
12 effective tools to slow down motor vehicle traffic and prevent
13 collisions; and

15 WHEREAS, installing speed bumps and speed limit signage
16 along Kapolei Parkway would help to reduce the number of
17 speeding vehicles on the roadway and protect the residents of
18 Kapolei; now, therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
21 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
22 Session of 2024, the Senate concurring, that the Department of
23 Transportation is urged to install speed bumps and speed limit
24 signage along the portion of Kapolei Parkway between Kapolei
25 High School and Kapolei Middle School; and
