

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THAT THE STATE AUDITOR CONDUCT A SUNRISE ANALYSIS OF FUNERAL DIRECTORS AND CEMETERY SALESPERSONS.

1 WHEREAS, although certain death care professions require licensure in the State, no licensure requirements exist for 2 3 funeral directors and cemetery salespersons; and 4 WHEREAS, due to its sensitive subject matter, greater 5 regulatory oversight of the death care industry is necessary; 6 and 7 8 WHEREAS, H.B. No. , introduced during the Regular 9 Session of 2024, establishes a death care industry board and 10 requires that funeral directors and cemetery salespersons be 11 licensed by the board; and 12 13 14 WHEREAS, section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, states 15 that "[n]ew regulatory measures being considered for enactment that, if enacted, would subject unregulated professions and 16 vocations to licensing or other regulatory controls shall be 17 referred to the auditor for analysis"; now, therefore, 18 19 20 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 21 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, the Senate concurring, that the Auditor is 22 requested to conduct a sunrise analysis of the licensing of 23 funeral directors and cemetery salespersons as proposed under 24 25 H.B. No. , which was introduced during the Regular Session 26 of 2024; and 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to 28 submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including 29 30 any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days before the convening of the Regular Session of 2025; 31 32 and
