
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

RECOGNIZING THE ISSUE OF ILLEGAL DUMPING WITHIN THE WAIPAHU
COMMUNITY AND URGING THE STATE, CITY AND COUNTY OF
HONOLULU, AND MILITARY TO WORK TOGETHER TO ADDRESS THIS
CONCERN.

1 WHEREAS, the act of illegal dumping poses significant,
2 environmental risks to the State's communities; and

3
4 WHEREAS, the disposal of waste materials in Waipahu
5 threatens public health and safety by contaminating soil, water
6 sources, and roads; and

7
8 WHEREAS, illegal dumping has led to a hazardous environment
9 that affects Waipahu's natural habitat and residents in the
10 surrounding area; and

11
12 WHEREAS, illegal dumping has resulted in less pride for
13 cleanliness throughout the Waipahu community; and

15 WHEREAS, most neighboring residents do not fully
16 acknowledge the same values to care for the Waipahu community,
17 which is creating an unhealthy environment for future
18 generations; now, therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
21 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
22 Session of 2024, the Senate concurring, that this body
23 recognizes the issue of illegal dumping within the Waipahu
24 community; and

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this body urges the State, City
27 and County of Honolulu, and military to work together to address
28 this concern; and
