A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that it is a matter of
statewide concern that the president of the University of Hawaii
serves simultaneously as the chief procurement officer for the
University of Hawaii system. The president of the system
simultaneously serving as the chief procurement officer leads to
inevitable conflicts of interest.

7 The legislature further finds that across the United States, the vast majority of public higher education 8 9 institutions, including the California State University system, 10 University of Massachusetts system, and University of Oregon 11 system, differentiate between institutional leadership and 12 purchasing when assigning the authority over procurement. While 13 the chief procurement officer for the Colorado State University 14 system possesses authority over system purchasing and 15 procurement as well as direct oversight over Colorado's 16 institutions of higher learning, there were no instances in

SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050;
provided that the amendments made to section 103D-203(a), Hawaii
Revised Statutes, by section 2 of this Act shall not be repealed
when that section is reenacted on June 30, 2024, pursuant to
section 16 of Act 8, Special Session Laws of Hawaii 2021.
