BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 706-663, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "§706-663 Sentence of imprisonment for misdemeanor and 4 petty misdemeanor. After consideration of the factors set forth 5 in sections 706-606 and 706-621, the court may sentence a person 6 who has been convicted of a misdemeanor or a petty misdemeanor 7 to imprisonment for a definite term to be fixed by the court and 8 not to exceed [one year] two years in the case of a misdemeanor 9 or [thirty days] one year in the case of a petty misdemeanor." 10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
