A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOMELESSNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) The homeless programs office of the 2 benefit, employment and support services division of the 3 department of human services shall establish and implement a 4 program to: 5 Acquire abandoned and vacant residential and (1) 6 commercial real properties; 7 (2) Repair any existing, or develop and construct new, 8 dwelling units on these properties; and 9 (3) Provide to individuals experiencing homelessness the 10 dwelling units repaired or constructed pursuant to 11 paragraph (2) for a term that the homeless programs 12 office deems appropriate. 13 (b) The homeless programs office shall submit a report on 14 the status of the establishment and implementation of the new

program required by this Act and the homeless programs office's

16 findings and recommendations, including any proposed



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1 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior 2 to the convening of the regular session of 2024. 3 (C) The homeless programs office shall adopt rules 4 pursuant to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as may be 5 necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Act. 6 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much 8 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the 9 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 10 2024-2025 for the establishment of a program to acquire abandoned and vacant residential and commercial real properties 11 12 to house individuals experiencing homelessness pursuant to 13 section 1 of this Act. 14 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department of human services for the purposes of this Act. 15 16 SECTION 3.
