The department of transportation and department of 5 (b) agriculture shall plan, design, and construct biosecurity, 6 inspection, consolidation, deconsolidation, and treatment 7 8 facilities for use by the department of agriculture to enhance 9 the efficient and safe movement of imported and exported marine 10 cargo, to include food [4] safety [4] and food security guidelines 11 and standards.

(c) The department of transportation shall install and use 12 13 at each commercial harbor electronic equipment capable of 14 scanning cargo container loads to detect illegal fireworks."
