BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 290, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§290-</u> Fees and fines; waiver. The directors of
5	finance of each county may waive, for a period not to exceed one
6	year after the subject charge, fee, or fine becomes due and
7	payable, payment of any outstanding tow, storage, or other
8	charge, fee, or fine owed to the county in accordance with this
9	chapter; provided that this section shall not apply to any tow,
10	storage, or other charge, fee, or fine incurred for a vehicle
11	deemed to be a derelict vehicle pursuant to section 290-8."
12	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
13	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
14	begun before its effective date.
15	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.



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1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
