### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THRILL CRAFT.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the advancement in 2 technology used for vessel and watersports equipment propulsion 3 has outpaced the State's ability to update its related laws. The legislature further finds that surfboards using motorized 4 5 hydrofoil technology are reaching speed capabilities of more traditional vessel types, such as thrill craft, and can present 6 safety concerns when motorized hydrofoil surfboards are operated 7 8 in areas intended only for non-motorized and manually powered vessels and equipment. The legislature recognizes that 9 non-motorized hydrofoils cannot reach speeds comparable to 10 motorized hydrofoils and therefore should not be considered 11 12 thrill craft under the state boating law.

13 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to modernize the 14 definition of thrill craft, as used in the state boating law, 15 and include within the term surfboards using a motorized 16 hydrofoil, also known as an e-foil.

8	(1)	[ <del>Is-generally-less</del> ] <u>Less</u> than [ <del>thirteen</del> ] <u>sixteen</u> feet	
9		in length as manufactured;	
10	(2)	[ <del>Is-generally-capable</del> ] <u>Capable</u> of exceeding a speed of	
11		[ <del>twenty</del> ] <u>fifteen</u> miles per hour;	
12	(3)	[ <del>Can be</del> ] <u>Typically designed to be</u> operated by a single	
13		operator, but may have the capacity to carry	
14		passengers while in operation; or	
15	(4)	[ <del>Is designed</del> ] <u>Designed</u> to provide similar operating	
16		performance [ <del>as</del> ] <u>to</u> a [ <del>personal watercraft</del> ] <u>"personal</u>	
17		watercraft", as defined in title 33 Code of Federal	
18		Regulations section 174.3, through a combination of	
19		small size, [ <del>power plant,</del> ] propulsion machinery,	
20		performance characteristics, and hull design.
