BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 54, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§54- Rounding up for teachers program.</u> (a) Each
5	board shall provide an option on each customer's utility bill
6	for the customer to voluntarily:
7	(1) Round up the total amount of the customer's water
8	utility bill to the nearest dollar amount; or
9	(2) Contribute a specific donation amount of the
10	customer's choice,
11	with the proceeds to be deposited into the rounding up for
12	teachers' salaries special fund established pursuant to section
13	<u>302A</u>
14	(b) Each option described in subsection (a)(1) and (2)
15	shall appear as a line item on the utility bill. The board
16	shall clearly indicate that:

14	(2)	Contribute a specific donation amount of the
15		customer's choice,
16	with the	proceeds to be deposited into the rounding up for
17	teachers'	salaries special fund established pursuant to section

4	(b) Subject to appropriation by the legislature, the
5	department may use moneys in the fund to provide additional
6	compensation for teachers, including through increases in
7	salaries or bonuses.
8	(c) The board shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 to
9	establish policies and procedures for the expenditure of moneys
10	from the fund.
11	(d) Any moneys deposited into the fund shall be in
12	addition to and shall not supplant any portion of the base
13	budget of the department of education."
14	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
15	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
16	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 to
17	assist the counties in implementing section 1 of this Act;
18	provided that the moneys shall be expended as follows:
19	(1) County of Hawaii \$
20	(2) County of Kauai \$
21	(3) County of Maui \$



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1	(4) City and county of Honolulu \$
2	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the respective
3	county for the purposes of this Act and shall constitute the
4	State's share of the cost of the mandated program under article
5	VIII, section 5, of the state constitution.
6	SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.
7	SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023;
8	provided that sections 1 and 2 shall take effect on July 1,
9	2024.

Electric Utilities; County Boards of Water Supply; DOE; Teachers; Compensation; Round Up; Special Fund; Appropriation

Description:

Establishes the rounding up for teachers' salaries special fund, to be administered by the Department of Education. Requires electric utilities and county boards of water supply to provide an option for customers to voluntarily round up their bill to the nearest dollar or provide a specific contribution amount. Deposits the proceeds into the rounding up for teachers' salaries special fund. Appropriates moneys.
