A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that government 2 transparency, in the form of the free flow of information 3 between the government and its citizenry, allows the public to review government decisions and provide meaningful feedback by 4 way of engagement in the political process. The electorate, now 5 6 well-informed on the decisions and actions taken by its government, may responsibly express their approval or 7 8 disapproval through the electoral process and through the formulation of policies and procedures promulgated through 9 10 administrative procedure.

11 The legislature further finds that capital improvement 12 projects are construction projects that provide improvements or 13 additions to land, buildings, and infrastructure. Since these 14 projects are typically large and expensive, the citizenry should 15 have the ability to publicly inspect projects completed or 16 pending and information related to those projects.
