
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ACCESS TO LEARNING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to clarify and make
2 adjustments to part V of Act 46, Session Laws of Hawaii 2020,
3 based on data and information from the university of Hawaii at
4 Hilo college of Hawaiian language program.

5 SECTION 2. Act 46, Session Laws of Hawaii 2020, as amended
6 by section 9 of Act 210, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021, is amended
7 by amending section 16 to read as follows:

8 "SECTION 16. The standards, assessments, performance
9 ratings, staff qualifications, and staff training requirements
10 established by this Act shall not apply to any laboratory school
11 program of the Hawaiian language college at the [University]
12 university of Hawaii at Hilo [~~until July 1, 2026~~]; provided that
13 all child care centers at any applicable college shall be
14 licensed by the department of human services [~~prior to~~] before
15 accepting children into care."

16 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
