## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 712-1248, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending subsection (1) to read as follows:
3	"(1)	A person commits the offense of promoting a
4	detriment	al drug in the second degree if the person knowingly:
5	(a)	Possesses fifty or more capsules or tablets containing
6		one or more of the Schedule V substances;
7	(b)	Possesses one or more preparations, compounds,
8		mixtures, or substances, of an aggregate weight of
9		one- eighth ounce or more, containing one or more of
10		the Schedule V substances;
11	(c)	Possesses one or more preparations, compounds,
12		mixtures, or substances, of an aggregate weight of
13		$[one ounce or]$ more $[\tau]$ than one ounce, containing any
14		marijuana; or
15	(d)	Distributes any marijuana or any Schedule V substance
16		in any amount."

3	"§712-1249 Promoting a detrimental drug in the third		
4	degree. (1) A person commits the offense of promoting a

6	possesses [ <del>any marijuana or</del> ] any Schedule V substance in any		
7	amount.		
8	(2) Promoting a detrimental drug in the third degree is a		
9	petty misdemeanor[ <del>; provided that possession of three grams or</del>		
10	less of marijuana is a violation, punishable by a fine of		
11	<del>\$130</del> ]."
