A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENERGY ASSISTANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to implement the
2	recommendations of the Hawaii low-income home energy assistance
3	program working group.
4	SECTION 2. Chapter 269, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5	amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
6	designated and to read as follows:
7	" <u>§269-</u> Hawaii low-income home energy assistance program
8	surcharge. The public utilities commission, by order or rule,
9	shall require that not more than per cent of the moneys
10	collected by Hawaii's electric utilities from its ratepayers
11	through a demand-side management surcharge be transferred to the
12	commission for deposit into the Hawaii low-income home energy
13	assistance program special fund established pursuant to
14	section 346-B."
15	SECTION 3. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
16	amended by adding two new sections to part I to be appropriately
17	designated and to read as follows:

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1	" <u>§</u> 34	6-A Hawaii low-income home energy assistance program;
2	<u>establish</u>	ed. (a) There is established the Hawaii low-income
3	home ener	gy assistance program. Subject to available funds, the
4	program s	hall assist eligible low-income households with their
5	energy co	sts, bill payment assistance, energy crisis assistance,
6	weatheriz	ation, and energy-related home repairs.
7	<u>(b)</u>	Any current beneficiary of the supplemental nutrition
8	assistanc	e program shall qualify for the program; provided that
9	the depar	tment may expand qualifications for the program based
10	<u>upon avai</u>	lable funds.
11	<u>(c)</u>	The department shall require recipients of funds from
12	the progr	am to participate in an energy audit of their home
13	<u>within tw</u>	o years of the first assistance received under the
14	program.	
15	(d)	The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
16	<u>91 for pu</u>	rposes of this section, including:
17	(1)	Determining the levels of assistance based upon income
18		and household size; and
19	(2)	Required energy efficiency improvements that a
20		recipient of funds shall complete to qualify for
21		further participation in the program.

17	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the			
18	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year			
19	2024-2025 for deposit into the Hawaii low-income home energy			
20	assistance program special fund.			

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1 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the Hawaii 2 low-income home energy assistance program special fund the sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 3 of \$ year 2023-2024 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be 4 necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for the Hawaii low-income 5 6 home energy assistance program. 7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 8 of human services for the purposes of this Act. 9 SECTION 6. In codifying the new sections added by sections 10 2 and 3 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute 11 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating 12 the new sections in this Act. SECTION 7. New statutory material is underscored. 13 14 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023. 15
