A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OPIOID ANTAGONISTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§302A- Opioid antagonist; classroom; training. (a)

5 Each department classroom shall be equipped with at least one
6 opioid antagonist.

7 (b) The department shall provide or coordinate with any
8 public or private entity to provide training to department
9 employees on:

10 (1) Opioid-related drug overdose prevention, recognition,
11 and response; and

12 (2) Opioid antagonist administration.

13 The board shall establish standards and frequency for the
14 training.

15 (c) An employee of the department who, acting in good
16 faith and with reasonable care, administers an opioid antagonist
17 to a student whom the employee believes to be suffering an



1 opioid-related drug overdose shall be immune from criminal
2 prosecution, sanction under any professional licensing law, and
3 civil liability for acts or omissions resulting from the
4 administration.

5 (d) As used in this section:

6 "Opioid antagonist" has the same meaning as in section
7 329E-1.

8 "Opioid-related drug overdose" has the same meaning as in
9 section 329E-1."

10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and the
13 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
14 2024-2025 for the purchase and placement of an opioid antagonist
15 in each department of education classroom and training of
16 teachers and other department of education employees on
17 opioid-related drug overdose prevention, recognition, and
18 response and opioid antagonist administration.

19 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
20 of education for the purposes of this Act.

21 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
