BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

Section 11-158, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 The chief election officer, or the clerk in the case "(a) 4 of a county election, shall conduct a hand recount of all 5 [votes] ballots cast for any office or ballot question in any 6 election if the official tabulation of all of the returns for 7 that office or question reveals that the difference in: 8 (1)The number of [votes] ballots cast for a candidate 9 apparently qualified for the general election ballot 10 or elected to office and the number of [votes] ballots 11 cast for the closest apparently defeated opponent; or 12 The number of [votes] ballots cast in the affirmative (2) 13 for the ballot question and the number of [votes] 14 ballots cast in the negative for the ballot question, including when applicable, the tabulation of blank 15 16 [votes,] ballots,

is equal to or less than one hundred [votes or] ballots, one quarter of one per cent of the total number of [votes] ballots
cast for the contest, or the margin of error for the tabulation

Report Title: Elections; Ballots; Ballot Questions; Recount

Description:

Specifies that a recount of all ballots cast for any election shall occur if the official tabulation of all of the returns for that office or ballot question reveals that there is a difference equal to or less than one hundred votes, one-quarter of one per cent of the total number of ballots cast for the contest, or the margin of error for the tabulation method utilized, whichever is greater.
