A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND TOURISM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 201-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§201-2 General objective, functions, and duties of
- 4 department. (a) It shall be the objective of the department of
- 5 business, economic development, and tourism to make broad policy
- 6 determinations with respect to economic development in the State
- 7 and to stimulate through research and demonstration projects
- 8 those industrial and economic development efforts that offer the
- 9 most immediate promise of expanding the economy of the State.
- 10 The department shall endeavor to gain an understanding of those
- 11 functions and activities of other governmental agencies and of
- 12 private agencies that relate to the field of economic
- 13 development. It shall, at all times, encourage initiative and
- 14 creative thinking in harmony with the objectives of the
- 15 department.



1	(b) The department of business, economic development, and
2	tourism shall have jurisdiction over state planning under
3	chapter 225M and the Hawaii State Planning Act under chapter
4	226. Due to the inherently interdependent functions of
5	development, planning, and land use, these functions shall not
6	be transferred by executive order, directive, or memorandum, to
7	any other department, nor shall these functions be subject to
8	review or approval by any other department.
9	(c) The department of business, economic development, and
10	tourism may acquire or contract to acquire by grant or purchase
11	real, personal, or mixed property or any interest therein; to
12	clear, improve, and rehabilitate and to sell, assign, exchange,
13	transfer, convey, lease, or otherwise dispose of or encumber the
14	same; and acquire property by condemnation pursuant to chapter
15	<u>101.</u> "
16	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
