RELATING TO FIREARMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	TON 1. The legislature finds that existing law allows
2	firearms to be lent to an adult for up to seventy-five days	
3	without any background check or notice to the government that a	
4	firearm has been lent to a person who does not have a permit for	
5	that weapon. The legislature further finds that this is not	
6	consistent with the rest of the firearm regulations, which	
7	requires background checks and permitting for all gun	
8	transferees.	
9	Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to:	
10	(1)	Restrict the loan of a rifle or shotgun to an adult
11		who is twenty-one years or older;
12	(2)	Repeal the authorization to lend a rifle or shotgun
13		without a permit;
14	(3)	Restrict the lending of a rifle or shotgun to twelve
15		hours;

1 Reduce the authorized lending of a rifle or shotgun (4) 2 outside of the State from seventy-five days to twelve 3 hours; Require that an adult who is borrowing a firearm 4 (5) 5 either possess a firearm permit or personally own or 6 possess a registered firearm, and is not prohibited 7 from owning or possessing a firearm; and Prohibit a person from knowingly lending a firearm, in 8 (6) 9 addition to a person who is prohibited from owning or 10 possessing a firearm, to a person who does not have a 11 firearm permit or does not own or possess a registered 12 firearm. 13 SECTION 2. Section 134-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 14 amended by amending subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows: 15 "(c) Any lawfully acquired rifle or shotgun may be lent to an adult who is twenty-one years of age or older for use [within 16 17 the State] for a period not to exceed [fifteen days without a 18 permit;] twelve hours; provided that [where the rifle or shotgun 19 is to be used outside of the State, the loan may be for a period 20 not to exceed seventy-five days.] the adult borrowing a rifle or 21 shotgun possesses a permit pursuant to section 134-2 or owns or

possesses a firearm that is registered pursuant to section 134-3, 1 2 and is not prohibited from ownership or possession of a firearm 3 pursuant to section 134-7. 4 No person shall knowingly lend a firearm to any person (d) 5 who does not have a permit pursuant to section 134-2, does not 6 own or possess a firearm that is registered pursuant to section 7 134-3, or is prohibited from ownership or possession of a firearm under section 134-7." 8 9 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 10 11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. INTRODUCED BY: Kal that 12

Report Title: Firearms; Lending; Firearm Permit; Firearm Registration

Description:

Prohibits a person from lending a firearm to a person who does not have a firearm permit or does not have a registered firearm. Requires an adult who is borrowing a firearm to have either a firearm permit or a registered firearm, and not be prohibited to own or possess a firearm. Specifies that an adult who is twenty-one years of age or older may be lent a rifle or shotgun for a period not to exceed twelve hours. Repeals the authorization to use a rifle or shotgun outside of the State for up to seventy-five days. Repeals the authorization to lend a rifle or shotgun without a permit.
