SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO ADOPT A POLICY RELATING TO COMMUNITY SCHOOLS TO GUIDE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ADDITIONAL COMMUNITY SCHOOLS THROUGHOUT THE STATE.

1 2	WHEREAS, every child should be given the opportunity to obtain a high-quality education; and
3 4 5	WHEREAS, community schools provide comprehensive programs and services to meet the unique needs of students and families,
6 7 8	including a lack of stable housing, inadequate medical and dental care, persistent hunger, trauma, and exposure to violence; and
9 10 11 12 13 14 15	WHEREAS, according to a report from the Learning Policy Institute, the four key pillars of a community-schools approach to education are integrated student supports, expanded and enriched learning time and opportunities, active family engagement, and collaborative leadership; and
16 17 18 19 20 21	WHEREAS, according to the national Coalition for Community Schools, best practice shows that having a dedicated, full-time Community School Coordinator who facilitates the alignment of school, family, and community resources is a core element of a successful community school; and
21 22 23 24 25 26	WHEREAS, the community school strategy aligns with the Department of Education's Nā Hopena A'o Framework, strengthening the sense of belonging, responsibility, excellence, aloha, and total well-being; and
27 28 29 30	WHEREAS, practices embodied in community schools promote conditions found in high-quality schools nationwide, especially with regard to overcoming out-of-school barriers to learning; and

1 2 WHEREAS, research shows that community-school interventions can result in improvements to a variety of student outcomes, 3 4 including attendance, academic achievement, and graduation 5 rates; and 6 WHEREAS, the Hawaii Consolidated State Plan under the Every 7 Student Succeeds Act includes community schools as a research 8 9 based strategy for school improvement that emphasizes highquality teaching, culturally relevant curricula, wraparound 10 11 student supports, positive disciplinary practices and 12 restorative justice, parent and community engagement, and inclusive school leadership; and 13 14 WHEREAS, community schools programs are already operating 15 in many parts of the State, especially in remote, rural, and 16 economically disadvantaged areas and more students and their 17 18 families could benefit from an expansion of community schools; 19 now, therefore, 20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 21 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, the 22 House of Representatives concurring, that the Board of Education 23 is requested to adopt a policy relating to community schools; 24 25 and 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Education is 27 28 urged to use the policy adopted by the Board of Education to 29 guide the expansion of community schools programs to additional 30 campuses; and 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 32 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the 33 Board of Education and Superintendent of Education. 34 35 36 37
