SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND HAWAI'I EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY TO ADOPT A CURRICULUM FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE YOUTH CIVIL DEFENSE CORPS.

WHEREAS, the Hawai'i Emergency Management Agency (HI-EMA) 1 serves as the official emergency management agency for the State 2 and is the primary coordinating agency between the State and 3 each county emergency management agencies; and 4 5 6 WHEREAS, as established under chapter 127A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, HI-EMA's primary role is to maintain a comprehensive, 7 coordinated, and cooperative emergency management program that 8 prepares for, mitigates against, responds to, and recovers from 9 emergencies and disasters that threaten or impact the State; and 10 11 WHEREAS, to effectively complete this broad mandate, HI-EMA 12 must establish a shared framework for the coordination of 13 response and recovery actions, including the organization of 14 state agencies, private sector entities, local communities, and 15 civilians; and 16 17 WHEREAS, during emergencies and disasters, pre-trained 18 volunteers can fill the need for additional emergency personnel; 19 and 20 21 22 WHEREAS, a youth civil defense corps, to be established by the Department of Education can enable HI-EMA to effectively 23 lead statewide emergency management efforts; and 24 25 WHEREAS, by training high school students through a civil 26 defense program, the Department of Education can further hazard 27 mitigation and recovery plan implementation in the event of an 28 emergency or disaster; now, therefore, 29 30 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 31 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, the 32

House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of 1 Education, in consultation with the Hawai'i Emergency Management 2 3 Agency, is requested to establish a Youth Civil Defense Corps; and 4 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Youth Civil Defense Corps 6 is requested to be administered at high schools to train 7 students to participate in the State Emergency Response Team 8 Program; and 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 11 12 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Superintendent of Education and Administrator of Hawai'i Emergency Management 13 14 Agency. 15 16 17
