SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A STREAM MAINTENANCE WORKING GROUP WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES.

1	WHEREAS, the flooding of streams has been a persistent
2	problem in Hawaii; and
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4	WHEREAS, trash and other debris can restrict the flow of
5	water through streams and other waterways, thereby preventing
6	the draining of stormwater and contributing to flooding; and
7 8	WUEDERS woody dobrig such as faller trace large and
o 9	WHEREAS, woody debris, such as fallen trees, logs, and branches, while important to the aquatic habitat, can also
9 10	obstruct drainage patterns and contribute to flooding; and
11	obstruct draimage pacterns and contribute to riobding, and
12	WHEREAS, the State and counties are statutorily required to
13	conduct maintenance for streams under their respective
14	jurisdictions, which includes stream cleaning and drainage
15	improvement projects; and
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17	WHEREAS, private landowners are responsible for stream
18	management on their properties; and
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20	WHEREAS, a common concern of homeowners and other
21	landowners is the accumulation of debris in the stream channel
22	that obstructs stream flow, which can lead to flooding; and
23 24	WHEREAS this problem is compounded by the illegal dymning
24 25	WHEREAS, this problem is compounded by the illegal dumping of trash that clogs and pollutes Hawaii's streams; and
26	or crash that crogs and portutes nawarr 5 streams, and
27	WHEREAS, the Department of Land and Natural Resources,
28	through its stream maintenance schedule, as well as other
29	departments and agencies that have jurisdiction over stream
30	maintenance, such as the Department of Education, are often
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unable to clear all streams ahead of events that could lead to 1 flooding; and 2 3 WHEREAS, proper stream management and maintenance are 4 essential to clear waterways and prevent flooding; and 5 6 WHEREAS, effective stream management and maintenance are 7 8 complex, multi-jurisdictional issues that require a high degree of collaboration and coordination, particularly in order to 9 10 reduce inefficiencies and ensure that upkeep is sustained over the long term; now, therefore, 11 12 13 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, the 14 House of Representatives concurring, that a Stream Maintenance 15 Working Group is requested to be established within the 16 Department of Land and Natural Resources; and 17 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Stream Maintenance Working 19 Group is requested to consist of the following members: 20 21 22 (1)A representative of the Department of Land and Natural Resources, to be designated by the Chairperson of the 23 Board of Land and Natural Resources and to serve as 24 chairperson of the working group; 25 26 A representative of the United States Army Corps of 27 (2) Engineers, Pacific Ocean Division, to be invited by 28 the chairperson of the working group; 29 30 (3) A representative of the Department of Education, to be 31 designated by the Superintendent of Education; 32 33 34 (4) A representative of the University of Hawaii, to be designated by the President of the University of 35 Hawaii; 36 37 (5) A representative of the City and County of Honolulu, 38 to be designated by the Mayor of the City and County 39 of Honolulu: 40 41

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A representative of the Hawaii Emergency Management 1 (6) Agency, to be designated by the Administrator of the 2 Hawaii Emergency Management Agency; 3 4 (7) A private landowner, to be invited by the Speaker of 5 the House of Representatives; and 6 7 A private landowner, to be invited by the President of 8 (8) 9 the Senate; and 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of the Stream 11 Maintenance Working Group are requested to serve without 12 compensation but may be reimbursed for necessary expenses, 13 including travel expenses, incurred in carrying out their 14 15 duties; and 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Stream Maintenance Working 17 Group is requested to determine and develop a comprehensive 18 solution for effective stream management and maintenance, 19 working in collaboration with and seeking input from other state 20 and county agencies, private landowners, and applicable 21 stakeholders; and 22 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Stream Maintenance Working 24 Group is requested to submit a report of its findings and 25 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 26 Legislature no later than twenty days before the Regular Session 27 28 of 2025; and 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and 30 Natural Resources is requested to provide any necessary 31 administrative and staff support to the Stream Maintenance 32 33 Working Group, including preparation of the report; and 34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 35 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Commander and 36 Division Engineer of the United States Army Corps of Engineers, 37 Pacific Ocean Division; Chairperson of the Board of Land and 38 Natural Resources; Superintendent of Education; President of the 39 University of Hawaii; Administrator of the Hawaii Emergency 40 41 Management Agency; and Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu. 42

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
