SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO PROVIDE A REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE REGARDING PUBLIC-SCHOOL CLASS SIZES.

1 WHEREAS, a well-rounded education requires manageable class sizes that allow teachers to deliver personalized and 2 individualized instruction to their students; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, the Institute of Education Sciences, the research 6 arm of the United States Department of Education, has concluded 7 that class-size reduction is one of only four evidence-based reforms that have been proven to increase student achievement; 8 and 9 10 WHEREAS, research by the National Education Association has 11 found that reducing class sizes in lower-income school districts 12 helps to increase student achievement and students' test scores, 13 alleviate strain on teachers, and raise college acceptance 14 rates; and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, additional research published by the Center for Educational Equity discovered that smaller class sizes may 18 attract high-quality teachers, leading to the adoption of 19 policies in California and Florida to reduce class sizes; and 20 21 WHEREAS, experiments in Tennessee, Wisconsin, and other 22 states have demonstrated that students in smaller classes score 23 better on standardized tests, receive better grades, and exhibit 24 improved attendance; and 25 26 WHEREAS, research also shows that the students who benefit 27 the most from smaller class sizes come from poor and minority 28 backgrounds, who experience twice the achievement gains of the 29 average student; and 30 31 32 WHEREAS, a study commissioned by the United States 33 Department of Education analyzed the achievement of students in

2,561 schools across the nation by their performance on the 1 National Assessment of Educational Progress and found that, 2 3 after controlling for student background, the only objective 4 factor that correlated with higher test scores was class size; 5 now, therefore, 6

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 7 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, 8 that the Department of Education is requested to provide a 9 report to the Legislature regarding public-school class sizes; 10 and 11

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the report is requested to 13 contain information on the number of classes at each school that 14 exceed the optimum class size ratios contained in Board of 15 Education Policy 106-2, including the subject matter and grade 16 level for these classes; and 17 18

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 19 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of 20 Education and Superintendent of Education. 21 22
