SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO CONDUCT A STUDY EVALUATING THE FEASIBILITY OF EXPANDING THE JURISDICTION OF ALL PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO INCLUDE A QUARTER-MILE RADIUS SURROUNDING EACH SCHOOL.

1 WHEREAS, youth participating in educational and recreational activities have the right to be free from bullying 2 3 and any form of violence; and 4 5 WHEREAS, bullying, and the related problems of harassment and retaliation, inhibit a young person's ability to learn and 6 7 an educational or recreational activity provider's ability to 8 teach students in a safe environment; and 9 10 WHEREAS, a safe and civil environment helps youth to learn 11 and thrive; and 12 WHEREAS, although students are protected by school staff 13 while on school grounds and in other areas within a school's 14 15 jurisdiction, many students are still being bullied and assaulted by other students off school grounds; and 16 17 WHEREAS, expanding a school's jurisdiction to areas in 18 close proximity and directly outside of its campus would allow 19 administrators to intervene and discipline students for actions 20 21 conducted against other students in situations that would have previously occurred outside their jurisdiction; now, therefore, 22 23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 24 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, 25 that the Department of Education is requested to conduct a study 26 evaluating the feasibility of expanding the jurisdiction of all 27 public schools under the Department's purview to include a 28 29 quarter-mile radius surrounding each public school; and 30
