## SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO DEVELOP A COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR THE REINSTATEMENT OF CANCELLED SCHOOL BUS SERVICE ROUTES.

1 WHEREAS, the availability of school bus services is essential to student attendance; and 2 3 4 WHEREAS, school bus services are particularly crucial for 5 families who live in rural and remote areas, as well as students who come from socioeconomically disadvantaged communities; and 6 7 WHEREAS, the Department of Education provides bus services 8 in neighborhoods across the State to ensure broad access to 9 educational opportunities for Hawaii's students, serving 10 11 approximately twelve thousand student riders on Oahu and thirteen thousand student riders on the neighbor islands; and 12 13 WHEREAS, currently, there is a nationwide shortage of 14 school bus drivers; and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, due to the shortage of qualified school bus drivers in the State, student bus transportation services have 18 been completely or partially suspended at ten Oahu high schools 19 and four schools on Kauai in the 2023-2024 school year; and 20 21 WHEREAS, suspensions of additional school bus service 22 23 routes in other counties of the State are anticipated if the shortage of qualified school bus drivers continues; and 24 25 WHEREAS, a comprehensive plan to reinstate previously 26 27 cancelled school bus service routes is needed to ensure that all students in Hawaii are able to use school bus services to arrive 28 29 at public schools on time; now, therefore, 30 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-second 31 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2024, 32

that the Department of Education is urged to develop a 1 comprehensive plan for the reinstatement of cancelled school bus 2 3 service routes; and 4 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Education is requested to submit the comprehensive plan, including any 6 7 findings, recommendations, and proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 8 9 the Regular Session of 2025; and 10 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to Chairperson of the Board of 12 13 Education and the Superintendent of Education. 14 15 16 OFFERED BY: \_
