SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A STREAM MAINTENANCE WORKING GROUP WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES.

1	WHEREAS, the flooding of streams has been a persistent
2 3	problem in Hawaii; and
3 4 5 6 7	WHEREAS, trash and other debris can restrict the flow of water through streams and other waterways, thereby preventing the draining of stormwater and contributing to flooding; and
8 9 10 11	WHEREAS, woody debris, such as fallen trees, logs, and branches, while important to the aquatic habitat, can also obstruct drainage patterns and contribute to flooding; and
12 13 14 15 16	WHEREAS, the State and counties are statutorily required to conduct maintenance for streams under their respective jurisdictions, which includes stream cleaning and drainage improvement projects; and
17 18 19	WHEREAS, private landowners are responsible for stream management on their properties; and
20 21 22	WHEREAS, a common concern of homeowners and other landowners is the accumulation of debris in the stream channel that obstructs stream flow, which can lead to flooding; and
23 24 25 26	WHEREAS, this problem is compounded by the illegal dumping of trash that clogs and pollutes Hawaii's streams; and
27 28 29	WHEREAS, the Department of Land and Natural Resources, through its stream maintenance schedule, as well as other departments and agencies that have jurisdiction over stream
30 31 32 33	maintenance, such as the Department of Education, are often unable to clear all streams ahead of events that could lead to flooding; and

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1	WHEREAS, proper stream management and maintenance are		
2	essential to clear waterways and prevent flooding; and

4	WHEREAS, effective stream management and maintenance are		
5	complex, multi-jurisdictional issues that require a high degree		
6	of collaboration and coordination, particularly in order to		
7	reduce inefficiencies and ensure that upkeep is sustained over		
8	the long term; now, therefore,

12	that a Stream Maintenance Working Group is requested to be		
13	established within the Department of Land and Natural Resources;

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A private landowner, to be invited by the Speaker of 1 (7) the House of Representatives; and 2 3 A private landowner, to be invited by the President of 4 (8) the Senate; and 5 6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of the Stream 7 Maintenance Working Group are requested to serve without 8 compensation but may be reimbursed for necessary expenses, 9 including travel expenses, incurred in carrying out their 10 11 duties; and 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Stream Maintenance Working 13 Group is requested to determine and develop a comprehensive 14 solution for effective stream management and maintenance, 15 working in collaboration with and seeking input from other state 16 and county agencies, private landowners, and applicable 17 stakeholders; and 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Stream Maintenance Working 20 Group is requested to submit a report of its findings and 21 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 22 Legislature no later than twenty days before the Regular Session 23 of 2025; and 24 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and 26 Natural Resources is requested to provide any necessary 27 administrative and staff support to the Stream Maintenance 28 Working Group, including preparation of the report; and 29 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 31 Resolution be transmitted to the Commander and Division Engineer 32 of the United States Army Corps of Engineers, Pacific Ocean 33 Division; Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural 34 Resources; Superintendent of Education; President of the 35 University of Hawaii; Administrator of the Hawaii Emergency 36 Management Agency; and Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu. 37 38 39 40
