Your Committee reviewed the personal history, resume, and statement submitted by Frank Goodale for service on the Real Estate Commission.

Your Committee received testimony in support of the nomination for the appointment of Frank Goodale from the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs and eight individuals.

Upon review of the testimony, your Committee finds that Mr. Goodale's knowledge, experience, and background qualify him for appointment to the Real Estate Commission as a licensee member from Hawaii county. Your Committee notes that Mr. Goodale has been licensed as a real estate broker in Hawaii since 1993 and is currently the Broker-in-Charge at SVN | GO COMMERCIAL, a commercial real estate firm in Kailua Kona. Previously, Mr. Goodale also served as President and Principal Broker at Clark Realty LLC and Clark Realty Corporation and as a sales agent with Bradley Properties, Ltd. Your Committee finds that Mr. Goodale's experience in managing multi-office brokerages with sales and
