- (1)Authorizing civil claims to be made against a person, business, business owner, or business operator that profits from sexual exploitation or sex trafficking; and
- (2) Extending the statute of limitations for civil claims related to sexual exploitation or sex trafficking to ten years.

Your Committee finds that this measure will provide victims of sexual exploitation or sex trafficking with an avenue for recourse and hold accountable those businesses, business owners, and business operators that profit from sexual exploitation or sex trafficking.
