The purpose of this measure is to appropriate funds to the Judiciary to support its 'Õlelo Hawai'i Initiatives.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Judiciary; one member of the Kaua'i Council; and one individual. Your Committee received testimony in opposition to this measure from the Center for Hawaiian Sovereignty Studies.

Your Committee finds that the 'Ōlelo Hawai'i program provides court interpretation, website translation, archival legal language research, and other services and resources for the public.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing the appropriation to an unspecified amount;
- (2) Changing the effective date to July 1, 3000, to encourage further discussion; and
