Madame:

Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 303, H.D. 2, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HEALTHCARE PRECEPTORS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to amend the Healthcare Preceptor Income Tax Credit by expanding the types of providers who are eligible to receive tax credits for acting as preceptors and adding the Director of Health and residency programs with eligible students to the Preceptor Credit Assurance Committee.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Health; University of Hawai'i System; Hawaii Health Systems Corporation Corporate Board of Directors; Hawai'i State Center for Nursing; Healthcare Association of Hawaii; Hawai'i Academy of Physician Assistants; Hawai'i Pacific Health; Hawaii Primary Care Association; Kaiser Permanente Hawai'i; The Queen's Health Systems; Hawaii State Chiropractic Association; Hawai'i-American Nurses Association; Hawaii Medical Association; and one individual. Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Department of Taxation; Tax Foundation of Hawaii; Hawaii Pharmacists Association; and numerous individuals.
