"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO STATE WATER CODE PENALTIES,"

The purpose of this measure is to:

- (1) Establish a minimum penalty, and amend the maximum penalty with scheduled incremental increases, per violation of the State Water Code and clarify what constitutes a separate offense; and
- (2) Require the Commission on Water Resource Management to consider certain factors when imposing penalties.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Hawai'i Reef and Ocean Coalition; Ulupono Initiative; Lāhainā Strong; and one individual. Your Committee received testimony in opposition to this measure from the Land Use Research Foundation of Hawaii.
