Your Committee on Culture & Arts, to which was referred H.B. No. 345 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE STATE SHRIMP,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to designate the 'opae 'ula as the state shrimp to help protect the anchialine pool ecosystems in the State.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Land and Natural Resources; Environmental Caucus of the Democratic Party of Hawaii; Hawai'i Alliance for Progressive Action; Hawai'i Ocean Legislative Task Force; Hawai'i Wildlife Fund; Kua'āina Ulu 'Auamo; Pacific Whale Foundation; and numerous individuals. Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Hawai'i Reef and Ocean Coalition.

Your Committee finds that 'opae 'ula are an endemic species found in abundance in healthy anchialine pools in the State. Your Committee also finds that anchialine pools are considered culturally sacred and should be protected. Your Committee believes that this measure will raise awareness of the protection efforts of anchialine pools by designating 'opae 'ula as the state shrimp.
