Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 430, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO INTERNSHIPS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to authorize and appropriate funds for the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations to administer an on-the-job training work experience program that partners with private entities to increase opportunities for eligible high school and college and university students to participate in summer internship programs and allow internships with private sector employers through a cost-sharing strategy.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the University of Hawai'i System; Department of Education; State Council on Developmental Disabilities; Healthcare Association of Hawaii; Pacific Resource Partnership; Hawai'i Regional Council of Carpenters; Kohala Coast Resort Association; Hawai'i Forest Industry Association; Hawai'i P-20 Partnerships for Education; Hawai'i Primary Care Association; Liberty Dialysis Hawai'i; Hawai'i Pacific Health; Hawaii Food Industry Association; Kapolei Chamber of Commerce; Hawai'i Lodging & Tourism Association; and Maui Chamber of Commerce. Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations.
