Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred H.B. No. 655 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES,"

The purpose of this measure is to limit the required payment of certain unpaid motor vehicle taxes and fees and accompanying financial penalties to those incurred during the most recent five consecutive years of delinquency.

Your Committee finds that this measure provides a statute of limitations on unpaid motor vehicle taxes and fees and penalties to address the uncertainty and administrative burden of these fees on residents and the government respectively.
