Your Committee on Water & Land, to which was referred H.B. No. 86 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to appropriate funds to the Department of Land and Natural Resources for the establishment of one full-time equivalent permanent Program Specialist V position to coordinate and implement actions necessary to meet the goals and objectives of the Makai Watch Program.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Office of Hawaiian Affairs; Department of Land and Natural Resources; Kua'āina Ulu 'Auamo; Hawai'i Ocean Legislative Task Force; Malama Pupukea-Waimea; Hawai'i Farmers Union; and two individuals.

Your Committee finds that the Makai Watch Program has been instrumental in fostering community engagement and effective comanagement of nearshore marine resources. Expanding this program, including establishing a permanent statewide coordinator, is critical to ensuring the long-term sustainability of Hawaii's marine ecosystems amidst growing environmental pressures.
