Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.B. No. 121
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE VI,
SECTION 3, OF THE HAWAII STATE CONSTITUTION TO ALLOW THE
SENATE MORE TIME TO CONFIRM JUDICIAL APPOINTMENTS,"

The purpose of this measure is to propose an amendment to
article VI, section 3, of the Hawaii State Constitution to allow
the Senate sixty days during certain times of the year in which to
consider and act on the appointments of justices and judges.

Committee on Finance that is attached to this report, your
Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 121
