Your Committee on Ways and Means, to which was referred S.B. No. 589, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to increase the availability, affordability, and production of renewable energy.

More specifically, the measure:

- (1) Authorizes the retail wheeling of renewable energy;
- (2) Requires the Public Utilities Commission to establish policies and procedures to implement retail wheeling and microgrid service tariffs; and
- (3) Requires the Public Utilities Commission to establish grid service compensation values that fairly compensate system owners.
