The Department of Budget and Finance supports moving this Administration proposal, or a similar bill, funding the collective bargaining agreement reached between the employer and the University of Hawai'i Professional Assembly for Bargaining Unit 7 for the period from July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2027. The agreement was ratified on October 17, 2024.

It should be pointed out that additional appropriations may need to be included in the measure to fund Employer Union Trust Fund contributions for the same period pursuant to the contract re-opener.
