- 5 Between 2014 and 2023, Hawaii reported 92 cases of Rat lungworm disease (RLWD), with the
- 6 majority of cases occurring on the Big Island (71 cases, 77%). RLWD is a disease that causes
- 7 substantial impairment to quality of life, is difficult to diagnose, and for which we are still
- 8 lacking strong evidence to guide treatment recommendations. There is critical need for ongoing
- 9 research into RLWD, and we are supportive of measures that promote and advance high quality
- 10 research to improve diagnosis, treatment, and/or prevention of RLWD.
