- 3 **Department Testimony:** Thank you for the opportunity to testify on this measure. The
- 4 EMSIPSB Branch provides the following testimony on behalf of the Department.
- 5 Established through HRS §321-225, the State Emergency Medical Services Advisory Committee
- 6 (EMSAC), within the Department of Health, provides advisory support on the state's emergency
- 7 medical services (EMS) system. EMSAC is comprised of twenty members designated by statute,
- 8 but meetings are attended by over fifty community members and healthcare professionals both in
- 9 person and virtually.
- 10 Currently, the committee faces challenges meeting the quorum requirement of 11 members, as
- 11 many members have demanding careers in emergency medicine, healthcare, and emergency
- medical services. Their professional responsibilities often require their sudden absence, making
- scheduling difficult. Additionally, vacancies on the advisory committee can hinder the ability to
- meet quorum. Without a quorum, the committee cannot conduct its business, which can delay
- essential decision-making and public discussions. Reducing the quorum requirement to seven
- members ensures that the committee can continue its important work even when full attendance
- is not possible. Seven members have proven to be a reasonable and feasible number to ensure

- 1 quorum, allowing critical discussions to occur without the need to cancel meetings at the last
- 2 minute.
