RELATING TO THE STATE BUDGET

The Department of Budget and Finance (B&F) offers comments on this bill.

Senate Bill No. 934, S.D. 2, appropriates an unspecified amount in special fund

ceiling for the Mass Transit Special Fund (MTSF) for FY 26 to make disbursements

pursuant to Section 248-2.7, HRS, provided that the Director of Finance determines:

1) the development of the minimum operating segment identified in the Amended Full

Funding Grant Agreement is completed; and 2) the development of the Pearl Highlands

park and ride facility is completed.

The S.D. 1 version of this measure provided an appropriation amount of \$572,695,000 in special fund ceiling for the MTSF in FY 26. B&F notes that this amount is included in both FY 26 and FY 27 via the Governor's FB 2025-27 Executive Biennium Budget (House Bill No. 300), that this amount continues to be included in the H.D. 1 version of the bill, and that B&F would prefer its inclusion in the final version of the budget bill.
