Dear President Kouchi and Speaker Nakamura:

The University of Hawai'i Professional Assembly and the employer have reached a tentative agreement concerning collective bargaining for Unit 7 (University of Hawai'i Faculty). Notice of ratification of the agreement was received on March 27, 2025. In accordance with Section 89-11, HRS, cost items must be submitted to the Legislature for appropriation. This agreement is an extension of the agreement reached in October 2024, and also includes amounts for Employer-Union Trust Fund (EUTF) contributions pursuant to the re-opener in that agreement. The following is a summary of the included and excluded requirements of the settlement for the current fiscal biennium which have already been transmitted to the Legislature for appropriation:

- 15 SECTION 10. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act
- 16 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2026, and
- 17 June 30, 2027, of the respective fiscal years, shall lapse as of
- 18 those dates.
- 19 SECTION 11. In accordance with section 9 of article VII of
- 20 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii and sections 37-91 and
- 21 37-93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the legislature has determined

- 1 that the state general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal
- 2 year 2025-2026 has already been exceeded by \$ or
- 3 per cent. In addition, the appropriations contained in
- 4 this Act will cause the state general fund expenditure ceiling
- 5 for fiscal year 2025-2026 to be further exceeded by \$
- 6 or one per cent. The reasons for exceeding the general fund
- 7 expenditure ceiling are that the appropriations made in this Act
- 8 are necessary to serve the public interest and to meet the needs
- 9 addressed by this Act.
- 10 SECTION 12. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.

## Description:

Provides appropriations for collective bargaining cost items for the members of Unit (7) and their excluded counterparts, including the cost of salary adjustments negotiated between the State and the bargaining unit representative for fiscal biennium 2025-2027. Declares the expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2025-2026 is exceeded. Effective 7/1/2025. (CD1)
