## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMERCIAL HARBORS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. (a) There is established the commercial harbors emergency evacuation working group within the department 2 3 of transportation for administrative purposes. 4 The working group shall: (b) 5 Review current federal and state laws regarding (1)6 emergency evacuation procedures for commercial 7 harbors; 8 (2) Determine whether there is adequate space in 9 commercial harbors for all vessels to moor should they 10 be required to evacuate Honolulu harbor and come up 11 with a comprehensive mooring plan; and 12 Review and evaluate whether current federal and state (3) 13 penalties are sufficient to ensure compliance with 14 emergency evacuation orders for commercial harbors. 15 (c) The working group shall consist of the following:

- (2) The chairs of the senate and house of representatives standing committees whose subject matter purview includes transportation;
- 7 (3) The United States Coast Guard captain of the port
  8 Honolulu sector, to be invited by the chair of the
  9 working group; and
- 10 (4) Users of the commercial harbors that are invited by
  11 the chair of the working group including but not
  12 limited to transpacific ocean carriers, interisland
  13 ocean carriers, a representative of the Hawaii
  14 Longline Association, a representative of the United
  15 Fishing Agency, cruise line operators, and tug and
  16 barge operators.
- 17 (d) The chair of the working group shall provide an option
  18 to attend each meeting remotely.
- (e) The members of the working group shall serve without
  compensation; provided that members who are employees of the
  State shall be reimbursed for expenses, including travel

- 1 expenses, necessary for the performance of their duties. No
- 2 member of the working group shall be subject to chapter 84,
- 3 Hawaii Revised Statutes, solely because of the member's
- 4 participation in the working group.
- 5 (f) The working group shall submit a report of its
- 6 findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 7 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 8 to the convening of the regular session of 2027.
- 9 (g) The department of transportation shall provide
- 10 necessary administrative support to the working group in
- 11 carrying out their duties, including facilitating stakeholder
- 12 engagement, arranging informational briefings, coordinating
- 13 relevant site visits, and preparation of the report pursuant to
- 14 subsection (f).
- (h) The working group shall be dissolved on June 30, 2027.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
