A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Motor Carrier

 Law recognized that "the transportation of persons and of
- 3 property, for commercial purposes, over the public highways of
- 4 this State constitutes a business affected with the public
- 5 interest" and the Motor Carrier Law intended "to provide for
- ${f 6}$ fair and impartial regulation of such transportation" in the
- 7 public interest. However, despite this articulated policy,
- $oldsymbol{8}$ existing law has provided a competitive advantage to newer
- $oldsymbol{9}$ business models buttressed by emerging technologies through an
- 10 exemption from the regulatory requirements under the Motor
- 11 Carrier Law, while established business models continue to be
- 12 subjected to those regulations.
- 13 Accordingly, the purpose of this part is to promote parity
- 14 and fair competition amongst the similar businesses that
- 15 transport persons or property over public highways by applying
- 16 on similar businesses the same regulatory framework enforced
- 17 upon motor carriers.



- 1 SECTION 2. Section 271-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§271-2 Administration; governing provisions of other
- 4 acts. This chapter shall be administered by the public
- 5 utilities commission of the State and the provisions of this
- 6 chapter and of chapter 269, not inconsistent with this chapter,
- 7 shall govern its administration; provided that sections $\left[\frac{269-4}{7}\right]$
- 8 269-9, [269-11,] 269-16 to 269-28, and 269-30 shall not, in any
- 9 respect, apply to the regulation of motor carriers."
- 10 SECTION 3. Section 271-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended as follows:
- 1. By adding three new definitions to be appropriately
- inserted and to read:
- ""Prearranged ride" means the provision of transportation
- 15 by a transportation network company driver to a passenger,
- 16 beginning when a transportation network company driver accepts a
- 17 passenger's request for a ride through a digital network or
- 18 software application service controlled by a transportation
- 19 network company, continuing while the transportation network
- 20 company driver transports the requesting passenger, and ending
- 21 when the requesting passenger, or the last passenger from the

1	requestin	g passenger's party, departs from the personal vehicle.
2	"Prearranged ride" does not include transportation provided	
3	through a ridesharing arrangement, as defined in section 279G-1;	
4	use of a	taxicab, limousine, or other for-hire vehicle; or a
5	regional transportation provider.	
6	"Transportation network company" means an entity that uses	
7	a digital network or software application service to connect	
8	passengers to transportation network company drivers; provided	
9	that the entity:	
10	(1)	Does not own, control, operate, or manage the personal
11		vehicles used by transportation network company
12		drivers; and
13	(2)	Is not a taxicab association or a for-hire vehicle
14		owner.
15	"Transportation network company driver" means an individual	
16	who operates a personal vehicle used to transport a passenger	
17	between points chosen by the passenger and prearranged through a	
18	transportation network company and that is:	
19	(1)	Owned, leased, or otherwise authorized for use by the
20		individual;

(2) Not a taxicab or for-hire vehicle; and

- 1 (3) Used to provide prearranged rides to passengers."
- 2. By amending the definition of "common carrier by motor
- 3 vehicle" to read:
- 4 ""Common carrier by motor vehicle" means any person that
- 5 holds itself out to the general public to engage in the
- 6 transportation by motor vehicle of passengers or property or any
- 7 class or classes thereof for compensation. "Common carrier by
- 8 motor vehicle" includes transportation network companies."
- 9 SECTION 4. Chapter 279J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 repealed.
- 11 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
