A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEAT DONATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 159, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§159- Further exemptions; food donations; wild game.
- 5 (a) This chapter shall not apply to the slaughtering of wild
- 6 game or the transportation or custom preparation of the
- 7 carcasses, parts thereof, and meat or meat products of wild game
- 8 at establishments conducting these operations if the articles
- 9 are wild game exclusively to be donated by a hunter for the use
- 10 or distribution by a charitable, religious, or nonprofit
- organization to needy persons pursuant to chapter 145D; provided
- 12 that the wild game shall not be combined with a meat food
- 13 product regulated under the Federal Meat Inspection Act,
- 14 title 21 United States Code section 601 et seq., or a poultry
- 15 product regulated under the federal Poultry Products Inspection
- 16 Act, title 21 United States Code section 451 et seq.; provided
- 17 further that the transportation of wild game shall be limited to

- 1 moving the wild game to and from the premises where the hunter
- 2 killed the wild game, the processing establishment, and the
- 3 charitable, religious, or nonprofit organization.
- 4 (b) For the purposes of this section, "wild game" means a
- 5 member of a species of game not indigenous to the State,
- 6 including axis deer, that is used for food, that is not
- 7 domesticated, and that is harvested in the wild. "Wild game"
- 8 includes the carcasses, parts thereof, and meat or meat products
- 9 derived from wild game."
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 145D-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- "[+] §145D-5[+] Reserving the State's authority to
- 13 regulate, inspect, or ban the use of donated food. Nothing in
- 14 this chapter or section 159- is intended to restrict the
- 15 authority of the department of health or the department of
- 16 agriculture to regulate, inspect, or ban the use of [such]
- 17 donated foods for human consumption."
- 18 SECTION 3. Section 159-29, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 19 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 20 "(c) The transportation by commercial carrier of
- 21 carcasses, parts thereof, or meat or meat products produced

- 1 without inspection under subsection (a) [is] shall be
- 2 prohibited, except under permit issued by the board [-] and under
- 3 section 159- ."
- 4 SECTION 4. Section 159-34, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 6 "(a) [The] Except as provided in 159-___, the preparation,
- 7 sale, offering for sale, or transportation or receipt for
- 8 transportation in intrastate commerce of meat and meat products
- 9 derived from exotic animals, unless inspected and passed as
- 10 provided for under this part, [is] shall be prohibited.
- 11 Violators shall be subject to all requirements and penalties of
- 12 this chapter."
- 13 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on December 31,
- 16 2050.

Exempts the donation of wild game meat or meat products, including axis deer, to a charitable, religious, or nonprofit organization for the purpose of feeding needy individuals from certain laws regarding the inspection and transportation of meat. Effective 12/31/2050. (SD1)
