### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-355, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+]\$11-355[+] Contributions by state and county
- 4 contractors; contributions by state and county grantees;
- 5 prohibited. (a) It shall be unlawful for any person who enters
- 6 into any contract with the State, any of the counties, or any
- 7 department or agency thereof either for the rendition of
- 8 personal services, the buying or leasing of property, or
- 9 furnishing of any material, supplies, or equipment to the State,
- 10 any of the counties, any department or agency thereof, or for
- 11 selling any land or building to the State, any of the counties,
- 12 or any department or agency thereof, if payment for the
- 13 performance of the contract or payment for material, supplies,
- 14 equipment, land, property, or building is to be made in whole or
- 15 in part from funds appropriated by the legislative body, at any
- 16 time between the execution of the contract through the
- 17 completion of the contract, to:

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1	(1)	Directly or indirectly make any contribution, or
2		promise expressly or impliedly to make any
3		contribution to any candidate committee or
4		noncandidate committee, or to any candidate or to any
5		person for any political purpose or use; [or]
6	(2)	Knowingly solicit any contribution from any person for
7		any purpose during any period[-]; or
8	(3)	Knowingly provide something of value to any candidate
9		committee or noncandidate committee or to any
10		candidate or to any person for any political purpose
11		or use, including advertisements.
12	(b)	It shall be unlawful for any person who applies for or
13	receives	a grant or subsidy from the State pursuant to chapter
14	42F, or f	rom a county pursuant to county charter or code, at any
15	time between	een the application for the grant or subsidy through
16	6 the completion of the contract, to:	
17	(1)	Directly or indirectly make any contribution, or
18		promise expressly or impliedly to make any
19		contribution to any candidate committee or
20		noncandidate committee, or to any candidate or any
21		person for any political purpose or use; or



(2) Knowingly solicit any contribution from any person for 1 2 any purpose during any period. 3 (c) It shall be unlawful for the owners, officers, 4 consultants, and any joint account holder of any state or county 5 contractor under subsection (a), at any time between the 6 execution of a contract through completion of the contract 7 pursuant to subsection (a), to directly or indirectly make any 8 contribution to any candidate committee or noncandidate 9 committee. (d) It shall be unlawful for the owners, officers, 10 11 consultants, and any joint account holder of any state or county 12 grantee under subsection (b), at any time between the 13 application through completion of the contract pursuant to 14 subsection (b), to directly or indirectly make any contribution 15 to any candidate committee or noncandidate committee. 16 [<del>(b)</del>] (e) Except as provided in [<del>subsection</del>] subsections 17 (a), (b), (c), and (d), this section does not prohibit or make 18 unlawful the establishment or administration of, or the 19 solicitation of contributions to, any noncandidate committee by 20 any person other than the state or county contractor, the state 21 or county grantee, or the owners, officers, consultants, and

- 1 joint account holders of a state or county contractor or state
- 2 or county grantee, for the purpose of influencing the nomination
- 3 for election, or the election of any person to office.
- 4 [-(c)] (f) For purposes of this section, "completion of the
- 5 contract" means that the parties to the government contract have
- 6 either terminated the contract prior to completion of
- 7 performance or fully performed the duties and obligations under
- 8 the contract, no disputes relating to the performance and
- 9 payment remain under the contract, and all disputed claims have
- 10 been adjudicated and are final."
- 11 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
